## **Do You Need Help Lowering Property Taxes? The Easthampton Senior Tax Work-Off Program can help!**

Easthampton homeowners who are 60 years of age or older and who meet income eligibility guidelines can apply to work for the city to receive a reduction in their Fiscal Year 2023 property taxes up to the amount of \$1500.

This program is in addition to other tax abatements and property exemptions for which senior taxpayers may be eligible.

Positions are located in many city departments and include:

- Filing, mailing, data input, inventory
- Custodial, landscape and garden maintenance, handy work
- Greeter, receptionist, event assistant, medical rides driver

Income Limitations – total gross annual income:

Married couples-----	<b>\$65,360.00</b>
Single-----	<b>\$57,190.00</b>

Ownership – Program participants must be the owner, or the spouse of the owner, of the assessed property on which the tax to be abated is assessed or have acquired ownership before the volunteer work is performed and the abatement is applied.
